FUTURE PREP SCHEDULE

Classes are "live" on the web with the guidance of an experienced instructor and are RAMP qualifying courses upon class completion and success on a post-test, where required. These courses may help improve your Selection Classification Code in RAMP.

Customer Contact Course

Learn skills to help you handle customers more effectively. This class may also help you improve how you communicate with people and prepare you for certain Verizon secondary tests. Class meets for 2 to 2 ½ hours once a week for 5 weeks

Mondays – May 7 through June 11, 2018 – 7:00 PM – 9:30 PM

Introduction to Telecommunications Technology Course

This class begins with the basics of electricity and progresses through topics like numbering systems and logic circuits, principles of transmission, copper media, and the basics of internet technology, to name a few. Useful discussions and illustrations make the content understandable for even non-technical students. Class meets for 2 to $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours once a week for 7 weeks.

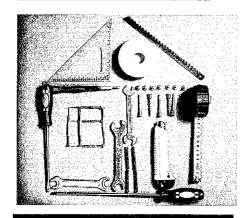

Health & Wellness Reimbursement

It's that time of year again! Time to take advantage of the ACFC's Health & Wellness Reimbursement Program! The ACFC will reimburse eligible employees for gym memberships or weight management programs up to \$100 from January - June 2018. All applications and accompanying paperwork must be postmarked on or before June 30, 2018. Be sure to include these items in your submission:

- A contract with the gym or program (If you have the same contract that was used in 2017, you do not have to send it again)
- Proof of payment up to \$100 within the applicable dates (January 1 – June 30, 2018 only)
- The contract and proof of payment must show the employee's name
- The employee's printed and signed name on the application
- The employee's Employee ID and Enterprise must be on the application (both can be found on the Verizon eWeb)
